In an effort to demonstrate our dedication and commitment to providing the community with excellent orthopaedic care professionals, we offer a variety of opportunities for students interested and committed to sports medicine and patient care careers.

The unpaid internship program is a competitive program that allows for immersion into the orthopaedic setting. Responsibility of a sports medicine intern include observing all aspects of a sports medicine practice including clinical evaluation and diagnosis, imaging techniques and therapies, surgical procedures, rehabilitation, and also be included in continuing education experiences offered to our medical students and orthopaedic fellows. Interns will also give a presentation at the end of their experience. This internship is not a hands-on clinical experience, rather an observational one.

We only allow two interns per month; this will allow each intern to have one on one interaction with their mentors (physicians, nurses, therapists, techs, etc.). We are currently accepting applications for summer 2012 (June and July). Application deadline is March 4, 2012.

Eligible applicants include undergraduate college students in their sophomore, junior or senior year and have completed one course of anatomy or anatomy and physiology.

A complete application includes:

- Application form
- Resume with a personal statement
- Two letters of reference (one must be academic)
- Official college transcript

Interns will be selected from the pool of applicants following our interview process. If accepted, you will be required to participate in orientation. As part of orientation you will have immunology testing for rubella, rubeola, varicella, and hepatitis B, as well as complete a two-step Mantoux test.
